# Recruitment Period

- New Admission : January ~ February (Contact your school of interest)
- Transfer Admission: January ~February, August (Contact your school of interest)

## Places for Issuance and Reception of Application Form

- Issuance of Application: Teachers' room or administrative office at each Open High School across the nation
- Reception of Application: Prepare forms and drop them off at the school of interest

## Required Documents

- New Admission: Middle school graduation certificate, a copy of resident registration, 3 passport photos
- Transfer Admission: Transcripts of student records from previous secondary schools, a copy of resident registration, 3 passport photos
- \*\* Application Forms and Privacy Policy Consent Forms are provided at each school. Schools may require students to submit additional documents if necessary.

- Middle school degree or the equivalent qualification
- Middle school GED (General Equivalency Diploma)




Open High Schools are established as affiliated schools at prestigious public high schools across the nation, so that students are able to attend classes near their home.






#### A school where anyone can enter

#### ■ Student Composition






