

Lifelong Education Program


- + Personality education program to prevent teenage students' school dropout and support returning students.

+ Online psychological tests and experts' on-site consulting service.


A school that acknowledges various learning experiences


A Yes, anyone who is qualified to enter high school is given an equal opportunity for secondary education regardless of age.





- Is it possible to maintain a balance between work and study?
- A Yes, offline classes occur twice a month (every other weekend), and students take cyber courses through the internet anytime and anywhere, so students can have both work and study life.
- If I graduate from Open High School, Can I apply for the university?
- A Yes, if you graduate from our Open High School, same as regular high school's required years of education, you will obtain 3 years of a regular high school diploma and you are eligible to apply for the university.
