

Application Guidelines

Eligibility

- Middle school graduates(expected) and those who have equivalent educational backgrounds are eligible
- Applicants who passed qualification exam for middle school graduation

Screening Process for Admission

- Non-testing screening process and first-served selection based on olders/order of arrival
- ※ It may vary depending on the admission criteria for each school

Recruitment Period

- **Freshman and Transfer Admission:** End of December~ End of February(Please contact relevant school)
- ※ It may vary by each school. Contact 1544-1294 or relevant school office directly

Places for Issuance and Reception of Application Forms

- **Issuance of Application:** Administrative office, academic affairs office of each Open High School
- **Document Submission:** Prepare forms and drop them off at the applicant's school of interest(identification card required)
- ※ Download application forms and required documents on the Open High School homepage(www.cyber.hs.kr) [Admission Guide → New-Transfer Admission]

Required documents

- **Both Freshman and Transfer**
 - 1 Admission application
 - 1 Resident registration certificate
 - 1-3 Passport photos
 - 1 Personal information collection·use consent form
- **New Admission**
 - 1 middle school graduation(expected) certificate or 1 copy of the passed certification of qualification exam for middle school entrance
- **Transfer Admission**
 - 1 current enrollment certified document
 - 1 copy of transcripts of student records from previously enrolled secondary school.

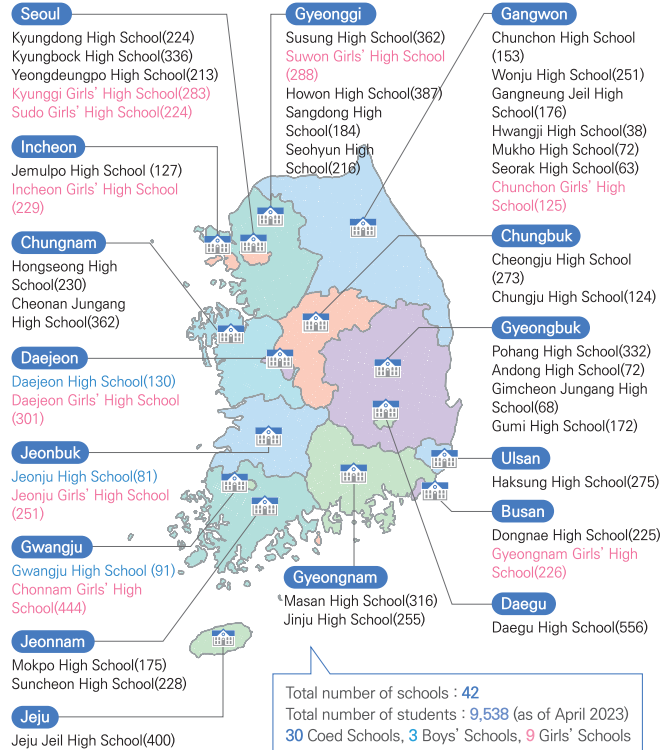

About Open High School

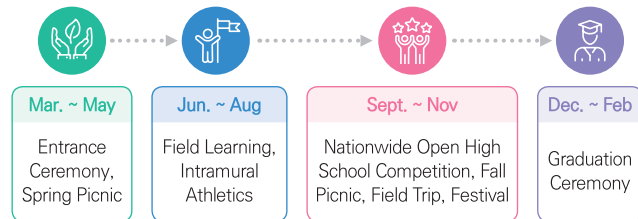
A school that students can attend from anywhere around the country

Students can study online using Open High School Learning Management Systems.

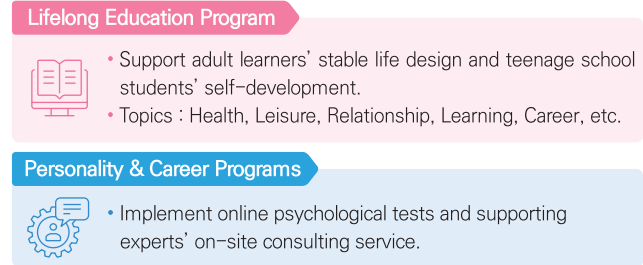


Utilize various devices such as PC, tablet PC, smartphone

Check personalized learning and customized learning progress rate via learning management system

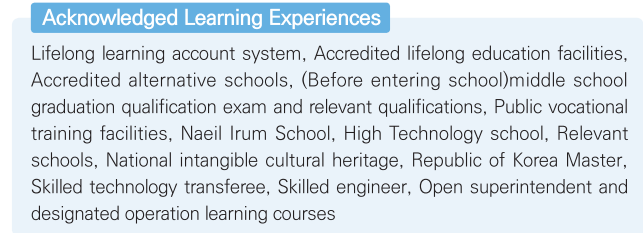
A school that provides customized education programs

Center for Open Middle and High schools offers education programs customized for students.



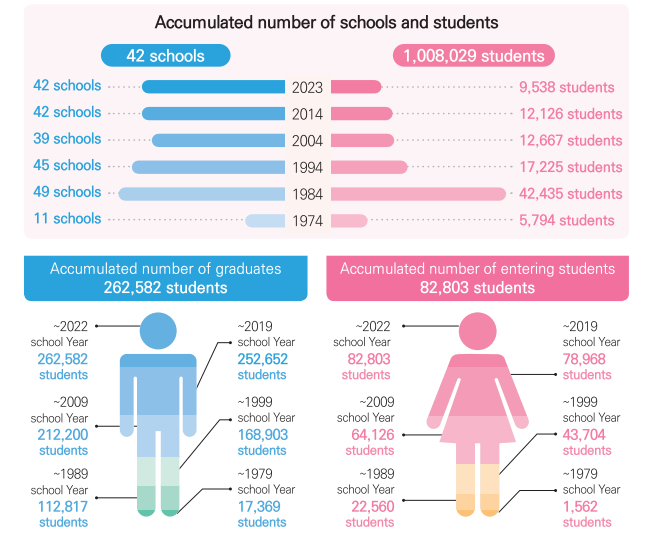
A school that acknowledges various learning experiences

Out-of-school learning experiences can be recognized as completing courses via the recognition of prior learning and students can graduate early up to one year.

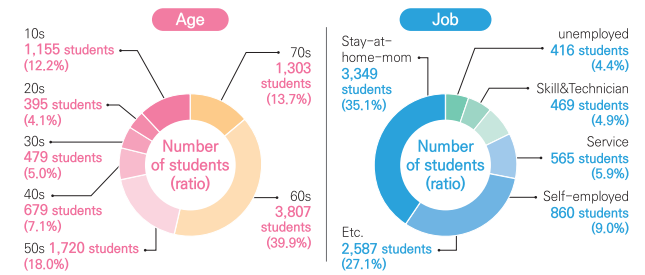


Open High School by Numbers
