

# Application Guidelines

## Eligibility

- Middle school graduates and those who have equivalent educational backgrounds are eligible.
- Applicants who passed the qualification exam for Middle school entrance.  
※ Entrance eligibility may vary under each city-province(schools) circumstances

## Screening Process for Admission

- Non-testing screening process and first-served selection based on olders/order of arrival  
※ It may vary under the admission criteria for each school

## Recruitment Period

- **Freshman and Transfer Admission:** End of December ~ End of February(Please contact the relevant school)  
※ It may vary under each school. Contact 1544-1294 or relevant school office directly

## Places for Issuance and Reception of Application Form

- **Issuance of Application :** Administrative office, academic affairs office of each Open High School or homepage
- **Document Submission :** Prepare forms and drop them off at the applicant's school of interest (identification card required)  
※ Download application forms and required documents on the Open High School homepage (www.cyber.hs.kr) [Admission Guide → New-Transfer Admission]

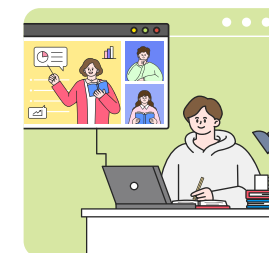

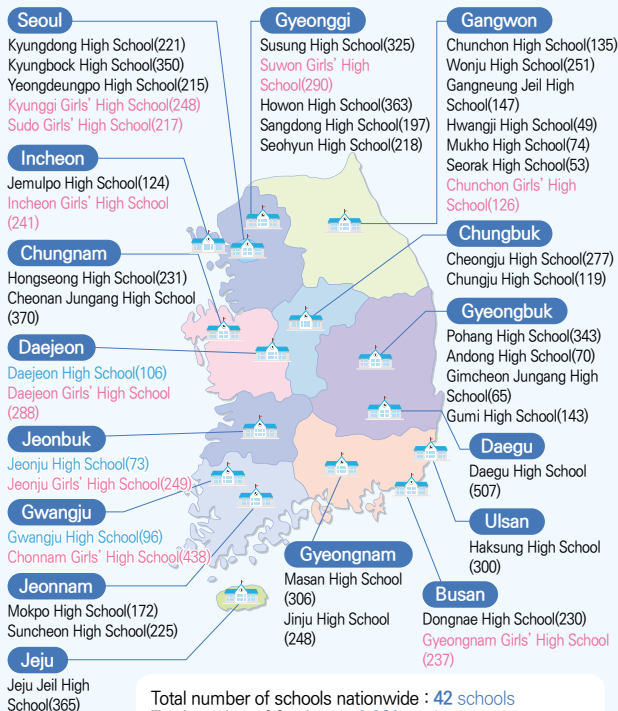


# About Open High School

Open High Schools are established as affiliated schools at prestigious public high schools across the country so that students are able to attend classes near their homes.

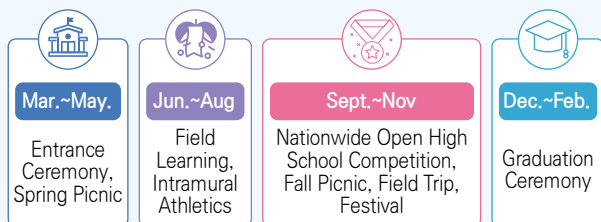

## A school that provides digital-based learning

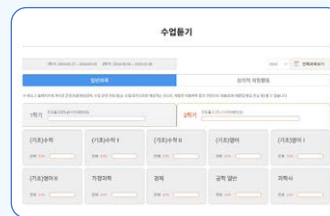
Students can study online using various devices on Open High Learning Management Systems.

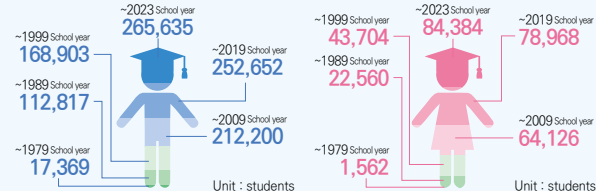


Accumulated number of graduates

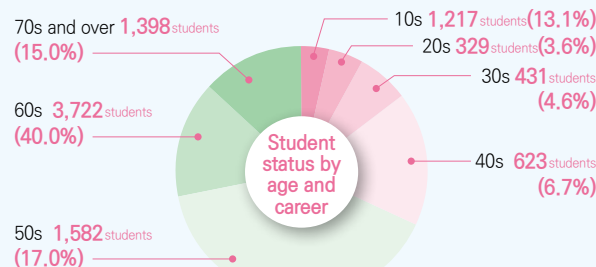

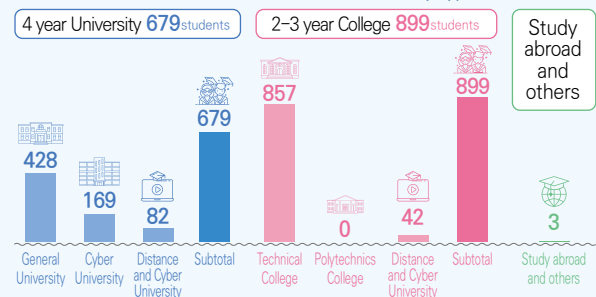
